Chimps & Bonobos



Chimpanzee, sometimes colloquially chimp, is the common name for the two extant species of ape in the genus *Pan*. The Congo River forms the boundary between the native habitat of the two species:

Common chimpanzee, *Pan troglodytes* (West and Central Africa) and Bonobo, *Pan paniscus* (forests of the Democratic Republic of the Congo)

Chimpanzees are members of the Hominidae family, along with gorillas, humans, and orangutans. Chimpanzees split from the human branch of the family about 4 to 6 million years ago. The two chimpanzee species are the closest living relatives to humans, all being members of the Hominini tribe.
